

DEFENSIVE AND COMPETITIVE BIDDING

OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; 1/2 Level; Reopening)

Aggressive. A level one response is F1
 After a 2/1 overcall new suit is F1
 All other bids (except cue bids) are natural and NF

1NT OVERCALL (2nd/4th Live; Responses; Reopening)

1NT shows 16-18hcp bal/sbal
 In reopening over minor 1NT shows 10-14
 In reopening over Major 1NT shows 11-15

JUMP OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)

Weak jump overcalls
 2NT shows the lower ranking suits
 reopen: 2NT natural, jump intermediate, double jump stronger

DIRECT AND JUMP CUE BIDS (Style; Responses; Reopen)

over 1♣: 2♣ is natural, 2♦ shows the majors
 over 1♦: 2♦ shows ♠+♥, 2NT shows ♠+♥
 over 1♥: 2♥ shows ♠+m, 2NT shows ♦+♣
 over 1♠: 2♠ shows ♥+m, 2NT shows ♦+♣

VS. NT (vs. Strong/ Weak; Reopening; PH)

Dbl 5+m/4M. 14+ over weak NT
 2♣ shows majors, 2♦ one major, 2♥/♠ with a minor

VS. PREEMPTS (Doubles; Cue-bids; Jumps; NT bids)

Takeout double up to 4♥, competitive doubles in higher level openings
 over 2M, 4m= 5m+5OM
 over 2♦ multi: dbl is takeout over 2♣ opening

VS. ARTIFICIAL STRONG OPENINGS

OVER OPPONENTS' TAKEOUT DOUBLE

rdbl: 10+, after which all doubles are negative

attitude: small encouraging, count: high low is odd
 whenever there is no point giving attitude/count we signal universal SP

DOUBLES

TAKEOUT DOUBLES (Style; Response; Reopening)

sound takeout doubles
 natural continuations.

SPECIAL, ARTIFICIAL AND COMPETITIVE (RE-)DOUBLES

In a blind 3NT bidding double asks for a ♠ lead
 If dummy has shows 1 or more suits double asks for dummy's first suit
 Lighner doubles in obvious situations

SYSTEM SUMMARY

GENERAL APPROACH AND STYLE

5 card Major openings, best minor openings
 1NT opening: 15-17 can have 5M or 6m
 Two over one response is always GF
 2♦ opening shows weak in a Major. 2M openings are two-suiters with a minor
 Negative and competitive doubles in most situations
 2♣ opening strong

SPECIAL BIDS THAT MAY REQUIRE DEFENCE

SPECIAL FORCING PASS SEQUENCES

When it is clear we have 23+ hcp

IMPORTANT NOTES THAT DON'T FIT ELSEWHERE

We do not pass when unclear
 We treat every unclear double as competitive

PSYCHICS: rare
